Many of us have taken this opportunity to reconnect with loved ones who have been separated by long distances. By the time you read this, Hanukah will be almost over. Again this year, there has been a rise in anti-Semitic attacks on Jews. This is alarming because there appears to be little pause in the hatred.

From antisemitism, it moves on to another minority group and another minority group until there's no one left to call out because all of the groups are no longer around.”

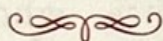

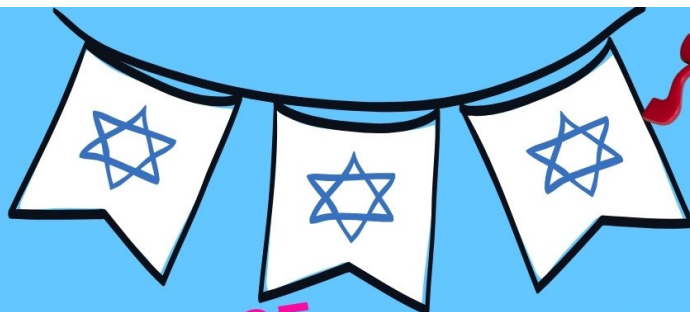
Peace, God, please, God.

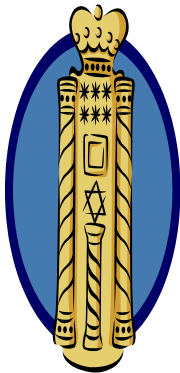

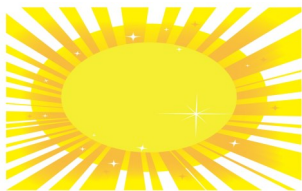
