Purim and Passover teach us that freedom isn't just a historical event—it's an inner journey. Like Esther, we must find the courage to speak up, even when it's hard; and, like Moses, we must believe that our words matter, even when we feel inadequate. This could mean standing up for a friend who is being treated unfairly, voicing an idea at work or in class even when we fear rejection, or having an honest conversation with a loved one despite the discomfort. In moments of hesitation, we must remember that the words we choose hold a power that can change the course of someone's life, including our own.

As we transition from Purim to Passover, let us embrace both the wisdom of silence and the courage of speech. May we, like Esther, use our voices to stand for truth, and may we, like Moses, trust that even our imperfect words can be transformative.

Our ability to speak is one of the greatest gifts we possess—may we use it to uplift, to heal, and to inspire. May our words be filled with kindness, our prayers with sincerity, and our voices with the power to bring peace and redemption to our world!

Long story made short, the King was looking for a new Queen and a young Jewish woman named Esther entered the competition (under the nudging of her uncle Mordechai) and became Queen. Esther actual saved the Jewish people from the evil Haman (the king's right-hand man). It is a true Jewish underdog story: the world was out to get us, (sound familiar?) but we persevered, did not shy away from our Judaic traditions and survived! 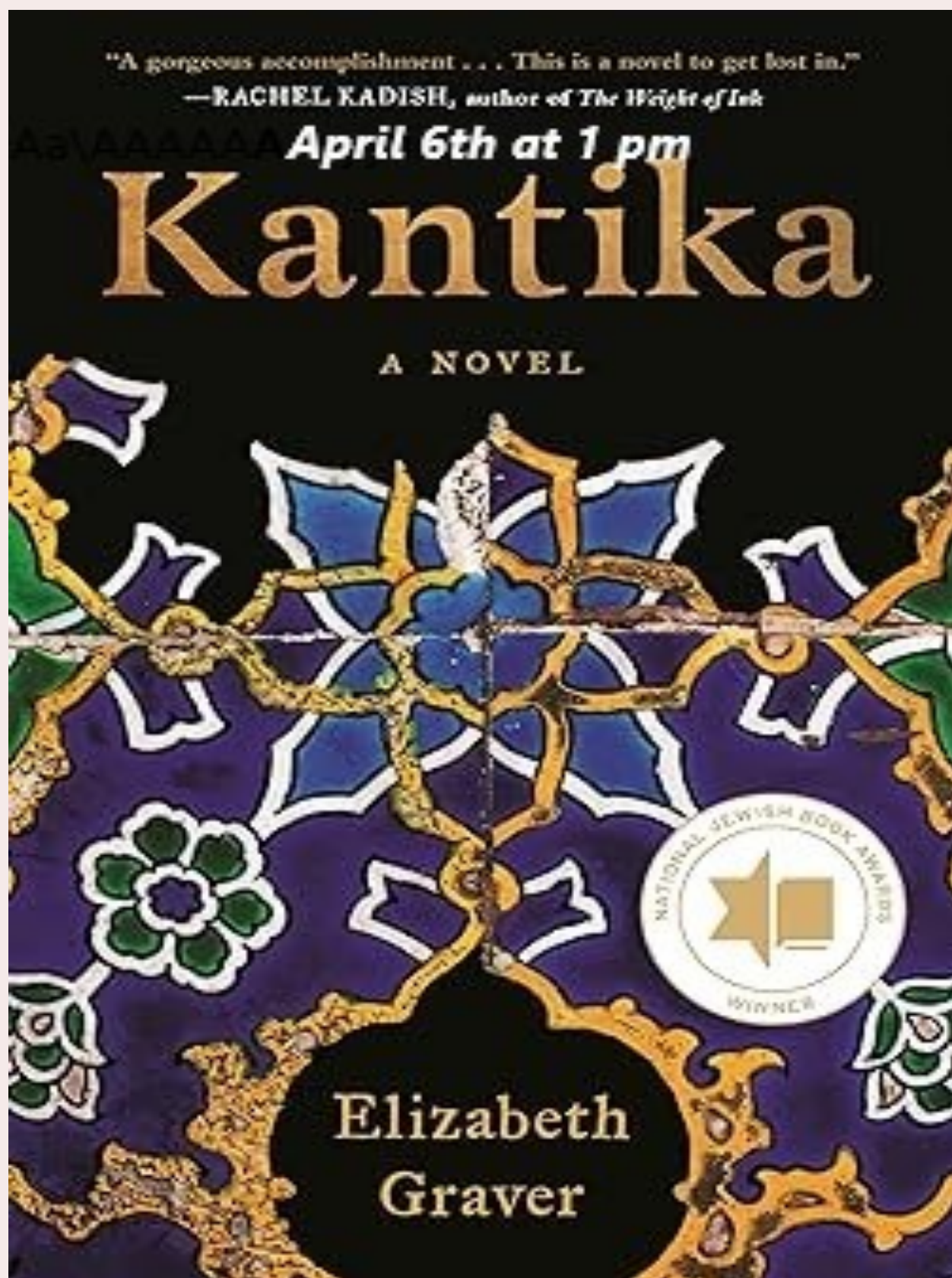

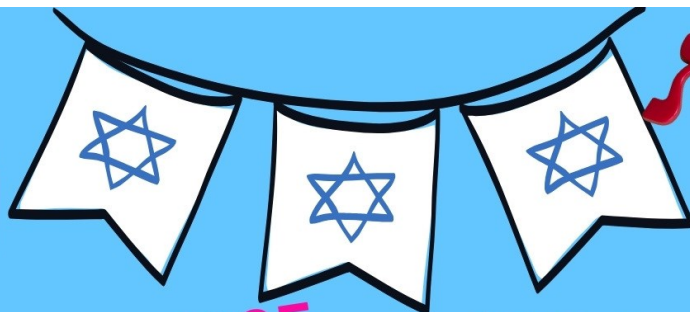
Peace, God, please, God.

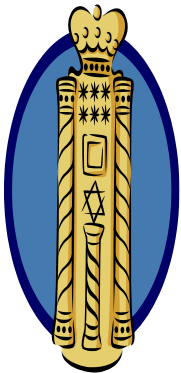
